

PART 3 TRAINING

Objectives

To produce a PDI who can teach *all* subjects to a pupil and all Pre Set Tests to an Examiner.

To produce a PDI who can Fault Find, Analyse and Correct (see it-say it-sort it) any pupils errors.

Method

- a) To cover *all* subjects (as needed by any pupil) as a basis and foundation to ongoing training.
- b) To cover each Pre Set Test subject relevant to Beginner; Part Trained; Trained and Full Licence Holder.
- c) At the same time as a) and b) above to practice Fault Identification and Remedy.

Method In Detail

- a) Trainer gives a Brief followed by practice using the PDI as a pupil.
- b) PDI gives the same Brief followed by practice using Trainer's lesson plan and the trainer as a pupil.
- c) PDI takes home a copy of the Trainers Lesson Plan and makes his *OWN* Lesson Plan.
- d) At some point PDI uses his own plan to give a lesson to Trainer.
- e) Trainer and PDI '*fault find*' driving to and from locations; trainer to demonstrate PDI to practice.

Training Time

- a) You will need at least 40hrs probably nearer 50 - it is a very demanding exam - the most frequent reason for failure is poor fault finding (*see it - say it - sort it*).
